- ❖ **50c per entry to a maximum of \$4 EXCEPT where specified**
- ❖ Entries close at 8.00am sharp on the day of the show.
Entries will be taken from 7.00pm to 8.00pm on the night before the show at the **Cyclone Shelter** at the southern end of **Florence Street**.
- ❖ **Any exhibitor or patron without conveyance may notify the Secretary.**
- ❖ Containers are available, but exhibitors may use their own and are responsible for the same.
- ❖ The decision of the Judges shall be final but the Committee reserves the right to deal with any disputes.
- ❖ All cash prizes will be awarded after 1pm.
- ❖ Any exhibit, which becomes the property of the show may be purchased but cannot be removed until the conclusion of the show at 2:30pm.
If you wish to retain ownership of your exhibit, please make this known at the point of entry.
- ❖ No prize will be awarded if there are fewer than two (2) exhibits in any class unless the Judge considers these exhibits merit an award.
- ❖ No second prize will be awarded unless there are three (3) entries and the Judge considers the exhibits merit an award.

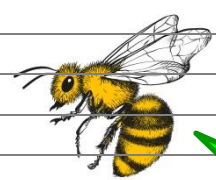
